Korean Exchange Program

Goals

- 1) To enrich the school's culture by enrolling students from different backgrounds.
- 2) To provide opportunity for the development of hospitable through which students and families enrich and bless each other.
- 3) To celebrate global diversity.
- 4) To provide opportunity for English skill development of participating Korean students.
- 5) To provide foreign students with excellent programs, taught in a Christian environment and from a biblical world and life view.

Highlights

- For students in grades 6 – 8
- Minimum of 4 weeks, maximum of 5 months
- Student must be able to converse in English; acceptance based on SLEP test >40, English interview by telephone, English transcript of last report
- Students are situated in OACS schools throughout Ontario
- Students are provided with an English immersion experience
- Students are placed in clean, secure and loving homestays organized by the school
- Guardian meets bi-weekly with students - guardian also maintains regular contact with host family and student's family
- Students receive *Certificate of Attendance* at end of program
- Year-round program, starting every month (except March, July, August, December)
- Deadline for application is one month before start of program

Costs:

The following amounts in Canadian currency include registration, tuition, homestay and medical insurance.

- 1 month: \$3650
- 2 months: \$4800
- 3 months: \$5950
- 4 months: \$7100
- 5 months: \$8250
