

# OACS Short Term International Student Programs



## Korean Schooling Program

### Goals:

- 1) To enrich the school's culture by enrolling students from different backgrounds.
- 2) To provide opportunity for the development of hospitable relationships through which students and families enrich and bless each other.
- 3) To celebrate global diversity.
- 4) To provide opportunity for English skill development of participating foreign students.
- 5) To provide foreign students with excellent programs, taught in a Christian environment and from a biblical world and life view.
- 6) To provide foreign students with stimulating cultural and recreational activities.

### Highlights :

Foreign students in grades 4 – 8:

- attend cluster schools in the OACS in grades 4-8 for either 2, 3 or 5 months, maximum of 3 international students per classroom;
- have one TA from their own country in each school;
- are immersed in the regular program taught by certified university-trained teachers;
- participate in ESL classes taught by international TA at appropriate times – during French instruction, for example;
- participate in Korean math program taught by Korean TA Saturdays 9:00 – 4:00 (except on Saturday planned trips)
- enjoy Saturday field trips once a month, accompanied by guardian;
- are placed in clean, secure and loving homestays organized by the schools;
- receive certificate of attendance at end of program;

*Deadline for Application is 45 days prior to start of program.*

### Costs:

The following amounts in Canadian currency include registration, tuition, homestay, medical insurance, and Saturday excursions.

- 2 months: \$5400
- 3 months: \$6850
- 5 months: \$9750
